Regular Meeting
April 14, 2022

The meeting was called to order at the Township Hall located at 135 Elm Street, Burlington, MI 49029 at 6:31 p.m. by Supervisor Eyre. There were over 30 in attendance so the meeting was moved outside. After the Pledge, roll was taken with Susan Mack, Jeffrey Eyre, Jeanette Demski, Darlene Mack and Barton Boyer present. **Public Comment Time** – Was opened at 6:32 p.m. and closed at 6:54 p.m. **Meeting Minutes** – **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Demski and carried to approve the meeting minutes from the March 10, 2022 regular meeting as written. **Financial Report** – written report was available for review. **Payment of Bills** – **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Demski and carried to pay bills totaling \$24,740.82. **2021-22 Budget Amendments** – **Motion** by Eyre, 2nd by S. Mack and carried to amend the 2021-22 Budget as follows: Township Board (101-802) 911 Dispatch by adding \$1060.00 and Fire Department (336-911) Fire Department Conference /Training by adding 340.00. **Road Committee** – hasn't meet. **Zoning Administrator** – Paul Walker's written report was reviewed by the board. **Fire Chief** – Norm Smith presented his report. **Supervisor** – nothing to report. **County Commissioner** – absent. **Building Committee** – hasn't meet. **Planning Chair** – absent. **Old Business:** none. **New Business:** **V Drive South between 8 & 9 Mile Road Return to Gravel Public Hearing** – **Motion** to open the public hearing by D. Mack, 2nd by S. Mack and carried at 7:00 p.m. Kori Albrecht from the Calhoun County Road Department was present to answer audience and board questions about the return to gravel process. **Motion** by D. Mack, 2nd by Demski to close the public hearing at 7:07 p.m. **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Demski and carried that in recognizing that more than 66.6% of the properties on V Drive South between 8 Mile Road and 9 Mile Road are represented by owner signatures on the petition to return this section of road from hard surface to gravel therefore, the Township Board will enter into an agreement with the County Commission to return this section of road to gravel with the County paying 100% of the cost, roll vote: Demski-yes, D. Mack – yes, Eyre-yes, S. Mack-yes, Boyer-yes. **O Drive South Road Restrictions** – **Motion** by Boyer, 2nd by Eyre to post no through truck signs on O Drive South between 11 Mile Road and 9 ½ Mile Road for trucks that do not have deliveries or farm land on that section of road. Roll call vote: Eyre-no, Boyer-yes, S. Mack-no, D. Mack-no, Demski-yes, **motion denied.** **Fire Truck Purchase** – After we made an offer pending the truck passing inspection and the offer was accepted, they sold the truck to another department. **Cemetery Flag Poles** – Barrington and Abscota flag poles have broken ropes that would take a high ranger to replace. Eyre will check on prices for poles that would make rope replacement easier. **Alvin Graber Conditional Use** – **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Eyre to approve the conditional use permit for Alvin Graber, roll call vote: Boyer-no, Demski-yes, D. Mack-yes, Eyre-yes, S. Mack-yes. **2022-23 Payroll/Contract Labor List** – **Motion** by S. Mack, 2nd by Boyer and carried to approve the 2022-23 Payroll/Contract Labor List as presented. **Fire Department Millage Renewal** – **Motion** by D. Mack, 2nd by S. Mack and carried with all in favor to approve Resolution #04-14-2022A to place the Ballot Proposal for Renewal Millage for Township Fire Operating Purposes on the August 2, 2022 election ballot. **Adjournment:** The meeting was adjourned at 7:29 p.m. by Supervisor Eyre.
