**Regular Meeting  
February 10, 2022**

The meeting was called to order at the Burlington Church of God located at 300 East Leroy Street, Burlington, MI 49029 at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Eyre with a large group in attendance. After the Pledge, roll was taken with Darlene Mack, Barton Boyer, Jeff Eyre, Susan Mack and Jeanette Demski present. **Public Comment Time** - Was opened at 6:31 p.m. and closed at 6:34 p.m. **Approval of Meeting Minutes - Motion** by Demski, 2<sup>nd</sup> by S. Mack and carried to approve the meeting minutes from 1/13/22. **Financial Report** - was presented by Treasurer Susan Mack. **Payment of Bills - Motion** by S. Mack, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eyre and carried to approve payment of bills totaling \$76,536.22. **Committee Reports: Road Committee** - Nothing to report. **Zoning Administrator - Land Division #173 - Motion** by D. Mack, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Boyer and carried to approve Land Division #173 for John Smith at 10325 N Drive South. **Fire Chief** - Chief Smith reported on the past month's activity and announced that the Pancake Supper will be March 19, 2022. **Supervisor** - Nothing to report. **County Commissioner** - Tommy Miller was present and answered audience questions. **Building Committee** - Nothing to report. **Planning Commission Chair** - Nothing to report. **Senior Millage** - Donna Rook provided information on services. **Old Business:** None. **New Business: Public Hearing for R/S Drive South Return to Gravel** - The hearing was opened at 6:47 p.m. with Kori Albrecht from the Calhoun County Road Department and Commissioner Tommy Miller present to answer audience and board questions. Much discussion was held with 3 property owners from the S Drive South section requesting their signatures be removed from the petition resulting in the S Drive South section being represented by less than 66.6% of the S Drive South property owners. Supervisor Eyre closed the R/S Drive South hearing at 7:42 p.m. **Public Hearing for 9 ½ Mile Road Return to Gravel** - The hearing was opened at 7:42 p.m. with Kori Albrecht from the Calhoun County Road Department and Commissioner Tommy Miller present to answer audience and board questions. Discussion was held and the hearing was closed by Supervisor Eyre at 7:56 p.m. **Motion** by Eyre, 2<sup>nd</sup> by D. Mack and carried that in recognizing that more than 66.6% of the properties on R Drive South between 8 Mile Road and S Drive South are represented by owner signatures on the petition to return this section of road from hard surface to gravel therefore, the Township Board will enter into an agreement with the County Commission to return this section of road to gravel with the County paying 100% of the cost, roll vote: Demski-yes, D. Mack - yes, Eyre-yes, S. Mack-yes, Boyer-yes. **Motion** by S. Mack, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Eyre and carried that in recognizing that more than 66.6% of the properties on 9 ½ Mile Road between N Drive South and R Drive South are presented by owner signatures on the petition to return this section of road from chip seal surface to gravel therefore, the Township Board will enter into an agreement with the County Commission to return this section of road to gravel with the County paying 100% of the cost, roll vote: Eyre-yes, S. Mack-yes, D. Mack-yes, Boyer-yes, Demski-yes. **McKenna Bid for Solar Ordinance** - Tabled. **Conditional Use Permit for M-60 Ballfields - Motion** by D. Mack, 2<sup>nd</sup> by S. Mack and carried to send the M-60 Ballfields Conditional Use Permit to the Township Planning Commission. **Special Meeting Date for Budget - Motion** by Eyre, 2<sup>nd</sup> by D. Mack and carried to set a special meeting for 2/23/22 beginning at 6:30 p.m. for the purpose of 22-23 Budget review and any other business that may come before the board. **Cemetery Lawn Care Bids** - Eyre will contact Brado's Tree Service. **Fire Truck #631** - Truck #631 will need to be replaced. **Motion** by Eyre, 2<sup>nd</sup> by D. Mack and carried to have Ken & Matt from Dependable Fire Apparatus inspect an available truck in Lavonia and get the results to the board for the special meeting on 2/23/22. The meeting was adjourned at 8:41 by Supervisor Eyre.
