The meeting was called to order at the Township Hall located at 135 Elm Street, Burlington, MI 49029 at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Eyre. There were 15 in attendance. After the Pledge, roll was taken with Susan Mack, Jeffrey Eyre, Jeanette Demski, Barton Boyer and Darlene Mack present.

Public Comment Time – Was opened at 6:30 p.m. and closed at 6:32 p.m. **Approval of Agenda** – Motion by S. Mack, 2nd by Demski and carried to approve the meeting agenda as presented. **Financial Report** – Treasurer’s written report was available for review. **Meeting Minutes** – Motion by S. Mack, 2nd by Boyer and carried to approve the meeting minutes from the September 8, 2022 regular meeting as presented. **Payment of Bills** – Motion by S. Mack, 2nd by Demski and carried to pay bills totaling \$243,354.13. **Road Committee** – has not met. **Zoning Administrator** – Paul Walker presented his written report. **Fire Chief** – Norm Smith presented his report. **Supervisor** – nothing to report. **County Commissioner** – absent. **Building Committee** – has not met. **Planning Chair** – Chad Blair was absent.

NEW BUSINESS: **320 Calhoun Street** – Motion by S. Mack, 2nd by Boyer and carried that dependent on our questions being answered regarding applying this cost to the property taxes and the assignment of a sheriff deputy to stand by at the location of cleanup, we accept the bid of \$5,500.00 from Twin Pines Transport LLC. **Township/Village Joint Property Sale** – Motion by D. Mack, 2nd by S. Mack to accept the counter offer of the Village at \$5,000.00 for the property sale and the Township paying ½ of the closing costs, roll vote as follows: Demski-no, Boyer-no, Eyre-yes, S. Mack-yes & D. Mack-yes. Village President Dowell was present and will proceed to start the sale process. **Barrington Cemetery Tree Work** – The work is nearing completion. **Conditional Use Fees** – Motion by Eyre, 2nd by D. Mack and carried to reimburse the following conditional use fees: Graber Lumber & Pallets \$326.00, Henry Eicher \$98.00, Alvin Graver \$1,198.00 and Ben Chard \$857.40. **Cemetery Garbage Service** – Garbage cans at the cemeteries are being filled with personal garbage. Motion by Demski, 2nd by S. Mack and carried to cancel garbage service at the M-60 and Abscots Cemeteries affective 12/1/2022. **6 ½ Mile Road Property** – A property on 6 ½ Mile Road is being used as a public dump. Motion by S. Mack, 2nd by Eyre and carried to direct Paul Walker to issue a citation to this property owner.
